We know Big Sandy is a long trip for many of you. However, an inbound or outbound sortie to cover the cost of fuel should help make the drive easier. Arrange this in advance.

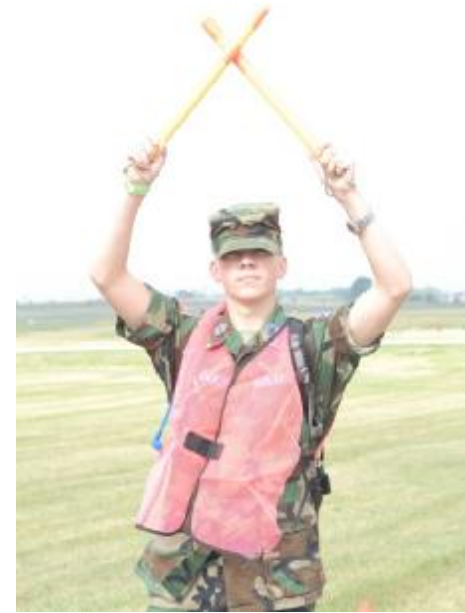
[This new facility](#) is a great place, and at a very reasonable cost. Each school fee will be priced according
